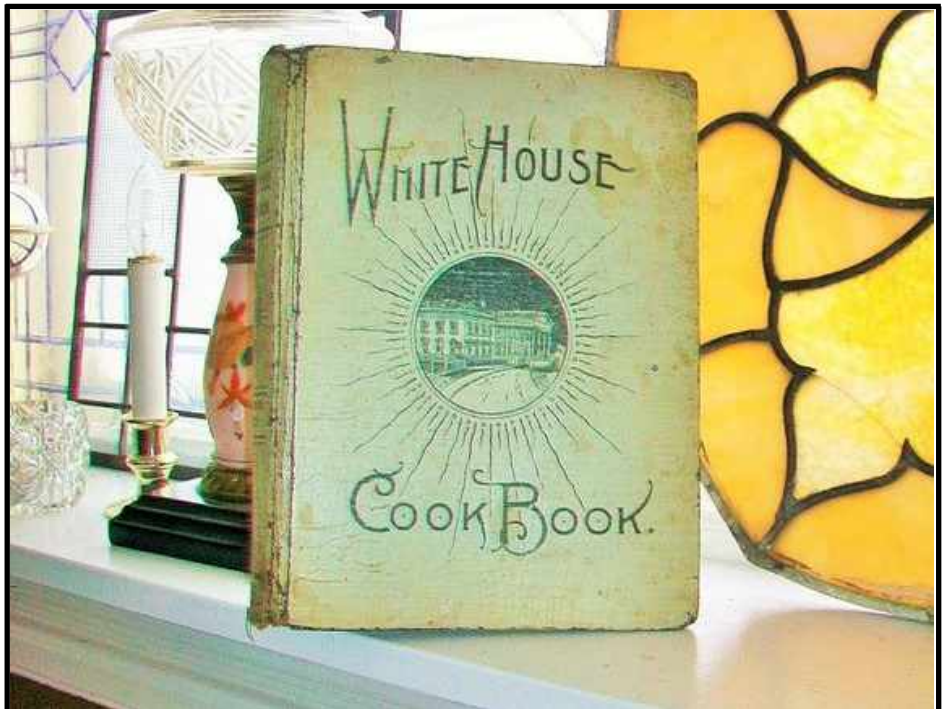
AAUW Winey Ladies
