



Legislative Updates

Three of our priority bills that were awaiting the Governor's signature have been signed:

- ➤ SB 62 (requires fair pay, instead of "by the piece" payment, for garment workers) **SIGNED**
- ➤ AB 367 (free menstrual products must be provided in girls/women's bathrooms in schools) SIGNED
- ➤ AB887 (allows domestic violence restraining orders to piled electronically) **SIGNED**

Abortion Justice

Although the constitutionally-guaranteed right to an abortion has been systematically under attack for decades, is currently in danger of disappearing altogether. As AAUW National recently noted, "Every person should have the ability to make their own informed decisions regarding their reproductive life. It is beyond time for abortion to be secured legally, funded fully, and equitably available for all who need it, when they need it, without shame or stigma."

With the recent refusal of the U.S. Supreme Court to intervene in the onerous Texas case, it is clear that we can no longer count on the courts to protect this critical right. Congress must pass the Women's Health Protection Act.
